Activity description

The Association Camphill Le Béal manages the center "Le Béal", which accommodates 23 mentally challenged people. Located in Drôme, in south-east France, in a rural area surrounded by nature and sunshine, 2 hours from Marseille and 1 hour from Valence.

Le Béal welcomes people recognized as "mentally handicapped adults", with a home placement (workshops and living quarters). There are two dimensions to the support provided to disabled people at Le Beal, which CES can help with:

- Daytime activities (gardening, cooking, farming, workshops, etc.) under the supervision of supervisors
- Day-to-day management support: people live in their own homes all year round. Professional supervision is required, and the CES will support these professionals (activities, games, evenings, outings, cultural events).
- The objectives are to enable these young people to support the team, to encourage individual and collective encounters with residents, to contribute technical and theoretical knowledge and to energize the project with initiatives and innovative projects according to the context and each of the players. The profiles of the selected candidates also aim to bring new perspectives to the project (music, art, etc.). Each ESC will have to propose a personal project and will be supported by the Beal.

Volunteers will be welcomed at the center Le Béal, ideally from September to June (10 months). Their mission will take place within the Foyer and in liaison with the Camphill Le Béal Association's partners (e.g. Taulignan commune, friendly associations, Taulignan school, training schools, etc.).
